<b>Requirements</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Student nomination from high school (1 per school)</li><li>• Must be enrolling in STEM programs at any participating Canadian university, most universities will accept the scholarship for their: Math, Engineering, Computer Science and some of the Biology/Chemistry streams</li><li>• High academic achievement (90+)</li><li>• Demonstrated perseverance, community leadership, passion for STEM development and innovation</li></ul>

### University of Western Ontario National Scholarship Program
